Roel Verhaak performed his graduate studies at the Erasmus University Medical Center in Rotterdam, the Netherlands, and was a postdoctoral fellow at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Broad Institute of Harvard and MIT, Boston, MA. The Verhaak Lab focuses on mechanisms of resistance to therapy in glioma, which his group interrogates through sequencing and computational biology approaches. This has involved the genomic and transcriptomic characterization of large cohorts of glioma patients. Recent work has identified extrachromosomal DNA elements as playing a critical role in glioma evolution, which may have important implications for the development of accurate biomarkers and novel therapies.
